

6. San Mateo County requests one council member per every 250 registered Green Party voters for Election 2000. At present that results in a council of 12 members. The council shall be elected proportionally by supervisory district.

Pursuant to Article XIV, "Candidates for Public Office" these are the official elections concerning partisan races:

As mentioned before, the Green Party is not contesting the Presidential Primary in 1992. The Green Party has also closed the long Senate seat and the short Senate seat in the 1992 primary.
